## WHAT HAPPENS WHEN BULLYING IS REPORTED?

1. Tell a teacher what happened truthfully and clearly.
2. The teacher will talk to the student /s involved.
3. If the bullying continues, either the student or the teacher can talk to the Wellbeing Leader or the Principal.
4. First incident - Mediation and agreed actions by bully.
5. Second incident – Two sessions out of the yard or in the office for one learning session.
6. Third incident – Parents notified, alternative play for a week or withdrawal from class for a half [1/2] day.
7. Any further incident - Suspension.

## WHAT IS BULLYING?

Bullying is an ongoing misuse of  
power in relationships through  
repeated verbal, physical and/or  
social behaviour that causes physical  
and/or psychological harm

It can involve an individual or a group  
misusing their power over one or  
more persons.

Bullying can happen in person or  
online, and it can be obvious (overt)  
or hidden (covert)

Bullying includes hurtful comments  
about a person's race, culture,  
appearance or gender.

Bullying includes excluding others  
from groups, threats, name calling  
and the spreading of rumours

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about a person's race, culture,  
appearance or gender

## WHAT YOU CAN DO IF SOMEONE BULLIES YOU?

- Stop and think. Don't bully back.  
Be part of the solution not part  
of the problem!
- Tell the bully to stop. Then walk  
away / look away

## WHAT IF THE BULLYING CONTINUES?

- Tell the bully one last time to  
stop it or you will report them to  
a teacher. Then walk away /  
look away.
