School Card is available in government schools to: families with children aged 4 years and over who attend a school full time independent full time students studying year 10, 11 or 12 adult re-entry students undertaking subjects to complete their SACE.

To qualify, your family's gross income in the 2021/22 financial year must be below the threshold, based on the number of dependent children you have in your family. Information on the eligibility criteria, income limits and the application process is available on
