School Card

School Card applications are now open! Now is a great time to see if you're eligible to receive financial assistance for school fees.

School Card is available in government schools to: families with children aged 4 years and over who attend a school full time.

To qualify, your family's gross income in the 2022/23 financial year must be below the threshold, based on the number of dependent children you have in your family. Information on the eligibility criteria, income limits and the application process is available on

School Card Applications can be completed online or you can come in to school and ask for a form.



All types of School Card applications are now online. You can access the online forms from any device that gets internet, including mobile devices, such as tablets and smart phones, as well as taptops and computers. Applying online is easy! Simply follow the steps below. STEP 1 Visit sa.gov.au/education/schoolcard STEP 2 Select the type of School Card you would like to apply for (for example Type A) and follow the prompts.
